Who Can Participate?

Any child who will be four years old by September 1, 2023 will be eligible to participate. Informational meetings are scheduled for Tuesday, January 31st and Thursday, February 2nd, 2023 and in person open houses on Ferbruary 4th 2023. Online Registration will open up on February 5th. How Much Will It Cost?

Wisconsin's school funding system provides funding for 4-Year-Old Kindergarten programs based on the number of students enrolled. There will be no charge to parents for district sponsored NR4K programming, no matter where the site is located. Sites that offer extended day childcare will still charge for childcare services. Check your site's handbook for the specific fee schedule.

What Can I Expect?

As an early education program, NR4K will focus on reading and language arts, but will also include math, social studies, science, health, physical education, creative art and music. Young children learn by doing, exploring, and experimenting in an integrated, nurturing environment. A typical day would include some teacher-directed instruction, many "hands-on" activities, and opportunities for child-initiated play.

Where Will My Child Go to NR4K?

The purpose of a community 4-Year-Old Kindergarten program is to collaborate with the existing expertise, experience and facilities of private providers in the community.
